






## Intellectual Skills

- Develop curiosity and a lifelong desire to learn.
- Transfer knowledge and information from one context to another.
- Perform tasks by following simple directions.
- Differentiate between make-believe and reality.
- Evaluate and form judgments about ideas and concepts.
- Compare facts and draw inferences to acquire deeper understanding.







# Auditory Discrimination Skills

- Distinguish differences in pitch, tone, tempo, and volume.
- Identify rhyming words.
- Recognize beginning sounds in words.
- Enhance attention span.


Develop both short-term and long-term memory.








## Visual Discrimination Skills



- Recognize similarities and differences in pictures, colors, shapes, sizes, letters, words, and numbers.
- Progress in visual tracking from left to right (e.g. printing their name) and top to bottom.
- Perceive and identify details in objects and pictures.
- Understand parts in relation to the whole, such as in solving picture puzzles.



## Pre-Reading Skills

- Browse through books for enjoyment and pleasure.
- Interpret and "read" pictures.
- Draw pictures and label them with names.
- Create drawings and narrate related stories.
- Recognize and understand common signs and symbols.
- Interpret and use calendars and clocks.
- Print their name and other meaningful words.





# Sensory Skills (Touch, Taste, and Smell)

### Each child will be encouraged to:

Observe and describe similarities and differences in shapes and textures.

• Feel and identify different temperatures of liquids.

• Taste and smell various substances to recognize and describe their similarities and differences.

Listen to and differentiate between various sounds.





## Comprehension Skills

- Increase understanding of conversation, discussions and oral presentations
- Increase participation in conversation and discussions.
- Identify the main idea.
- Recall information presented.
- Put events in sequence.
- Draw conclusions
- Make inferences.

## Listening Skills




- Follow directions attentively.

# Speaking Skills

- Communicate fluently with organized thoughts.
- Develop effective questioning skills.
- Use correct grammar in speech.
- Articulate clearly and appropriately for their age level.
- Employ proper voice inflections to convey meaning.
- Adjust volume according to the speaking situation.
- Speak in complete sentences.
- Expand vocabulary through new experiences.
- Participate actively in conversations and discussions.
- Express themselves confidently in front of others.









## Number Skills

- Establish one-to-one correspondence between two groups of objects.
- Understand concepts of equality and inequality.
- Identify the number of objects in a set.
- Select the correct set of objects when given a number.
- Recognize the ordinal position of objects in a sequence.
- Recite numbers in order.
- Use numbers in everyday activities, such as counting items (e.g. cookies).
- Comprehend and discuss time sequences, such as yesterday, today, and tomorrow.
- Identify and name various geometric shapes.
- Use comparative terms like "greater than," "less than," and "equal to."
- Make simple quantitative estimations.
